Steps taken from submission until approval

- <u>22 September 2014</u>: Submission of the 1st Draft of the Programme Document to the EC
- 12 May 2015: Submission of the final Draft of the Operational Programme, via SFC, to the EC
- 30 June 2015: Meeting of the IPA Committee, to approve the New Programme

Approval Decision of the Programme by the EC: C (2015) 5482

Date of Approval: 30 July 2015

Period of eligibility of expenditure

The <u>starting date</u> for the eligibility of expenditure of beneficiaries is:

- Greece: the 1st of January 2014
- Albania: the 22nd of September 2014

The <u>closing date</u> of the eligibility period of the expenditure should be the end date of the subsidy contract in force.

The final date of eligibility of expenditure cannot exceed the 31st of December 2023.

Guiding Principals for Selection of Operations General Rules

- For all thematic areas priority will be given to:
- Projects with broad area impacts/significance over projects with localized effects, unless the latter are pilot actions with best practice potential (in this case transferability will have to be demonstrated)
- Projects following the principles (as applicable) of equality between men and women, non-discrimination and accessibility to persons with disabilities, and sustainable development.
- Projects with significant cross border impacts
- All infrastructure and media (including electronic media) projects shall meet the requirements of the General Regulation 1303/2013, article 7 concerning the implementation of the principles of non discrimination and accessibility to persons with disabilities.

Main differences compared to the 2007-2013 Programme

- Over 50% increase on Programme's total budget (42.312.029€, instead of 27.825.759€)
- Eligible cross-border area has expanded greatly
- National contribution of Greece declined 10 percentage units (from 25% to 15%)
- New Regulations
- Implementation under the shared management approach

Main differences compared to the 2007-2013 Programme

- Single Managing Authority (MA)
- Single Certifying Authority (CA)
- Single Audit Authority (AA) supported by Group of Auditors
- One Subsidy Contract
- Single reporting procedure
- Single Lead Beneficiary
